## "Perspective for Plein Air Painting", Ken Klos

OSA's Plein-Air juried show will be in the gallery during the month of August. What could be more useful and timely than to have Ken Klos, a plein-air artist, share his knowledge with OSA members? Ken is a senior project architect/project designer, licensed in the states of Oregon and California. He knows his perspective. During this demo, he will show how to apply this know-how in setting up a plein-air painting.

## "Collage Storytelling", Colin Manning

Colin Manning will give an introduction to his medium's potential for storytelling, personal expression and social commentary. In the spirit of exploration, he will show how his collage subject emerges by searching through magazines and books to find images that speak to him.

Colin received his BFA in Painting and his MFA in Filmmaking from the San Francisco Art Institute. Through a technique of collaging and painting applied "backwards" to glass and plexiglass, Manning conjures up a dynamic confluence of the transcendent and mundane.

Manning is also known for his projection performances, utilizing multiple film, slide, and overhead projectors loaded with handmade and hand-altered film. Peruse his website at colinmanning.org

The French term *En Plein Air*, or "in the open air" refers to drawings and paintings that are completed on location outdoors. This presentation explores the experience of what the eye sees and the heart and hand expresses. The act of painting outdoors has allured artists for centuries to heighten the visual senses, producing either a quick study painting, or a finished work of art. Among the notable plein-air artists are Claude Monet, Mary Cassatt, Winslow Homer, Pierre-Auguste Renoir, Vincent Van Gogh, and Winston Churchill, just to name a few.
