



Learn the art of reverse glass painting. Nicole will lead students in designing their composition on paper, transferring their image onto glass before beginning the painting process with painted lines and details using a reverse layered process. Students will explore techniques on a smaller sheet of glass before moving on to paint their larger framed piece. This is an old art form (we will discuss it's fascinating history) and yields beautiful results. Because the work is painted on the back side, finished work viewed from the front of the glass shines like a jewel and can be washed like any piece of glass.

Materials List:

- *acrylic paint in a variety of colors (warm and cool)
- *fine black paint pen (deco-paint or sharpie brand)
- *gold 7/or silver paint pen
- *regular black sharpie marker
- *a few round paint brushes, size 2 or so, size 5 or so
- *a couple flat paint brushes, size 5 or so
- *a few q-tips, paper towels
- *picture frames: one around 8x10, another about 11x14 or larger (16x20)
