

**Materials list for**  
**Black and White and Red All Over Workshop**

**Paper:**

Hotpress watercolor paper that works well with pens and watercolor.  
(I've been using Stonehenge Aqua Hotpress, 9 in. X 12 in.)

**Pens and pencils:**

Black permanent marking pens of various sizes  
( I use Sharpie fine point, Pigma Micron 05, 08, 12)

Any pencil will do, but I recommend hard lead or mechanical which  
leave very light lines.

**Watercolor paints and brushes:**

A small palette with a variety of bright primary/secondary colors  
2 or 3 small round brushes

**Reference materials:**

Bring reference materials to help come up with shapes (animals,  
birds, flowers, etc.) if you want, but imagination and memories  
work well also!
