

Supplies for Pocket Sketching Workshops

INSTRUCTOR BRINGS SUPPLIES SO YOU DON'T HAVE TO GO FIND THESE! The cost is \$50.00 for paint set, paper, pen, manual, water container, color chart, Swiss knife to open paints, candle stub.

Paint Set: Winsor & Newton 14 half pan, Cotman grade watercolor set. (Comes with an acceptable brush)

Paper: Strathmore 4 x 6 inch Drawing paper. (Not the watercolor paper sold in the same size)

Pen: Pilot Razor Point. This is the old grey pen with a yellow circle on one end. An indelible pen (brand being researched).

Water container (I bring 35 mm film canisters for everyone)

Manual on the unusual characteristics of the Pilot water-soluble pen.

Extras: If you have a #6 round watercolor brush, bring it. For outdoors on last day you may want a hat, sunblock, folding seat, water bottle (to drink and supply extra water for painting), insect repellent.

An excellent field seat is made by GCI, will hold 250 pounds, doesn't tip over, has a padded back rest and seat, and no arms (which get in the way). It's the best I've found so far. (Amazon, GCI Quik E Seat, \$55.48)
