

Anji Grainger 2023 Workshop Supply List

Basic Items that you will need to bring:

- Your regular watercolor supplies – palette and watercolor paints, brushes, artist quality paper, water container, towel, etc.
- One bottle each of Dr. PhMartin's Hydrous Watercolors: Hansa yellow Medium, Quinn Magenta and Thalo Blue
- 300 or 140 pound hot press Arches watercolor paper, or yupo.
- **2 half inch foam core or gator boards slightly larger than your paper – note these must be the thicker ½ inch size. Foam core is much less expensive than gator board!** You can also tape together 2 pieces of ¼ foam core. Actually anything that you can put a stick pin into will work.
- Pencil and eraser for sketching
- **Stick pins/plastic head thumb tacks**
- **Dried leaves, ferns and other plant materials that you gather ahead of time and flatten in a book**
- A sack lunch

Optional items not required but would be fun to try:

- Ampersand claybord or aquabord
- American Easel Water Media Panel
 - Note: Smooth surfaces –like Hot Press watercolor paper, Ampersand's AquaBord, Claybord and Yupo–work the best with the techniques we will explore.

For this workshop I am providing spray bottles and mixing materials for preparing your liquid watercolors as well as several different types of texturing materials. Bring your imagination and prepare to create in a fun and nonthreatening way!
