

Pen and Ink with Watercolor Workshop Supply List

- ❖ Archival black ink pens – waterproof (very important)
Archival Ink pens come in various sizes: .005, 1.0, 3.0, 5.0 for example. You can purchase a set for a great price at Dick Blick and other fine art stores
- ❖ Here are some suggested brand names:
 - Sakura Pigma Micron
 - Staedtler
 - Prismacolor
 - Faber Castell
- ❖ One small bottle of India ink
- ❖ One white gel pen
- ❖ One full sheet of Arches 140 pound hot press or cold press paper 22" x 30" (**not broken down- we will need a small portion of the full sheet to create the journal so it must be in it's full size**). Hot press is smoother and will give more even lines however, I use cold press and it works just fine.
- ❖ One Small piece of 300 pound Arches watercolor paper (for the cover of your journal) - the size should be big enough to get two 4" x 6" pieces out of it.
- ❖ Your regular watercolor supplies – brushes, paints and palette, pencil, eraser, etc.
- ❖ I will provide images to work from but you are welcome to bring some images of your own.

Some extra options if you like, **not required**:

- Colored archival ink pens
- Sepia Pens – give a nice vintage look
