

Materials Lists:

Materials I provide for students to borrow:

- 1 each of these 3 grades of graphite pencils: Tombow 2H, HB and 2B
- 1 Faber Castell Polychromos colored pencil in Dark Sepia (#175)
- A small 6" ruler
- Canson Tracing paper
- Blue painter's tape
- White plastic eraser
- Plexiglas plane*
- Wet erase pen*

Materials I provide for students to keep:

- Folio of Handouts
- A few sheets of Strathmore Drawing 400 paper in 9x12", 14 x 17" or both
- A small kneaded rubber eraser
- An eraser shield
- Mounting putty

Materials students need to bring themselves:

- A drawing board and some sort of table easel - Your drawing board could be a piece of Masonite or Gatorboard (16x20" is a good size). It should be firm board with a smooth surface – no texture. And for your "easel" - a towel rolled up and secured with a few rubber bands around it makes a great means of elevating your drawing board for a proper tilt.
- Possibly a container to hold your specimen (you'll be notified in advance if one will be needed.)

Recommended but not required:

- A hand pencil sharpener or battery-operated pencil sharpener. (We will have one or two pencil sharpeners available for everyone's use in the classroom, but you might want to have your own since we do a good bit of sharpening.)
- A magnifying glass

Other:

* I'll have some materials that students may want to purchase, including Plexiglas Planes and Wet Erase Pens, among other items. Prices on request

- For people who would like to try working in colored pencil on watercolor paper, I'll have some Fabriano Artistico Watercolor paper (140#, Hot Press), available in letter size sheets.
